

### Burton / Sherman Transitional Housing Rules

- 1) The length of stay at \_\_\_\_\_ is three (3) months.
- 2) No alcohol and/or drugs, other than prescription medications will be permitted. All prescribed medications must be kept in the private living quarters of the occupants.
- 3) No person under the influence of drugs/alcohol is permitted on the premises at any time.
- 4) In order to remain a resident in Transitional Housing, you are required to sleep at the house, all night a minimum of five nights per week. You may only be away from \_\_\_\_\_ for NO more than two nights within one week.
- 5) There is NO SMOKING in the homes whatsoever, under any circumstances. You are permitted to smoke outside only. You may not throw your cigarette butts on the ground. Please dispose of your cigarette butts in a safe, flame resistant container, making sure that the flame is completely extinguished before leaving.
- 6) No guests are permitted in the individual bedrooms at any time.
- 7) No overnight guests are permitted.
- 8) No females are permitted on the premises of the men's home at any time, and no males are permitted on the premises of the women's home at any time.
- 9) No unrelated children are permitted in the residence at any time.
- 10) Garbage cans must have a liner and must be covered at all times. Place garbage at the curb for collection.
- 11) Do not store or place anything on the stairs or in the stairwells.
- 12) Living areas must be clean and odor-free at all times. Linens and towels must be washed once a week.
- 13) No items are to be hung on walls, unless hung by CHC/OMCDC.
- 14) No furnishings or household items shall be removed from the house. All furnishings and household items are property of CHC/OMCDC.
- 15) No food storage or cooking is permitted in the bedrooms.
- 16) When exiting the living space, make certain that all doors and windows are locked.

- 18) No flammable liquids are to be stored in the premises.
- 19) Each client is expected to uphold the dignity and respect the privacy and rights of the other clients.
- 20) Any failure to comply with the rules/and or failure to pay rent or damages will result in termination from Housing Program.
- 21) The list of House Rules is subject to change at any time by the CHC/OMCDC, and is not inclusive of the responsibilities of the client.
- 22) Client agrees to remain a client of the CHC/OMCDC.
- 23) Client agrees to maintain the Treatment Plan assigned while maintaining residence at the Transitional Homes. Client shall adhere to all policies and procedures set by the treatment and housing staff.
- 24) Client agrees to weekly inspections of individual and shared living spaces.

**I have received, read and understand the House Rules, for said Premises. By signing this agreement, I understand that violation of either the House Rules or violation of my Lease terms, including the Treatment Agreement, will result in termination of my housing status.**
